**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA,  
ALASKA, ADOPTING THE BREAKWATER EXTENSION PROJECT AS A  
FY11 CAPITAL FUNDING PRIORITY**

**WHEREAS**, the harbor is an essential part of Cordova's marine-related infrastructure, yet due to a gap in the existing breakwater design, there is a serious lack of protection to both vessels and users; and

**WHEREAS**, currently, the harbor and its users are exposed to storms from the north which are capable of causing serious damage and potential danger to life; and

**WHEREAS**, a breakwater extension is necessary to protect the harbor and the vessels that utilize it; and


**WHEREAS**, the design phase for this project has been funded by the Denali Commission and completed by the US Corps of Engineers; and

**WHEREAS**, funding in the amount of 3.1 million dollars is needed to complete construction.


