**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA,  
AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION AND  
MAJOR EXPANSION MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Cordova, Alaska acknowledges the Cordova Public Library will be a part of the Cordova Center project to provide improved public library service to the community of Cordova; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cordova Public Library is an applicant for a grant in the amount of One Million Two Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand One Hundred dollars (\$1,269,100) from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (hereinafter "Department"), under the Library Construction and Major Expansion Matching Grant Program; and




**WHEREAS**, the City of Cordova continues to support the Cordova Center project and has committed to the long term operating and maintenance of the Cordova Center;
