**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA,
AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF \$36,010 TO ALPINE DIESEL FOR REMOVAL
OF THE SPARTAN FROM THE CITY OF CORDOVA HARBOR, AND
AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION AND 2010 BUDGET
AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ACCOUNT NUMBER 502-400-52180,
IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$36,010, IN THE HARBOR ENTERPRISE FUND**

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2010 a vessel named the SPARTAN was found sinking in the City of Cordova Harbor, and

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2010, Mr. Terry Lonborg of Olympia, Washington, the person who had claimed ownership of the vessel on the Harbor registration form, was notified that the SPARTAN was in imminent danger of sinking and that the City would be removing the vessel from the Harbor, and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2010, no action having been taken by Mr. Lonborg, the City hired Alpine Diesel to remove the boat and place it in dry-dock, and

WHEREAS, the cost of removal was \$36,010 which is above the spending authority of the City Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Cordova, Alaska, hereby authorizes payment of \$36,010 to Alpine Diesel for removal of the SPARTAN from the City of Cordova Harbor, and authorizes supplemental appropriation and budget amendment to professional services account number 502-400-52180, in the total amount of \$36,010, in the Harbor Enterprise Fund.


