**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA,
DESIGNATING STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
CONSERVATION (ADEC) GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED LT2
COMPLIANCE UV TREATMENT FACILITY AS THE NUMBER ONE LOCAL STATE
FUNDING PRIORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Cordova, Alaska through the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation will request grant funding for the LT2 Compliance UV Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation has requested that the City of Cordova identify if this project is the community's number one local state funding priority for fiscal year 2012; and

WHEREAS, the LT2 Compliance UV Treatment Facility is to provide compliance with federal EPA mandated Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule (LT2) for inactivation of Cryptosporidium. The UV project includes two UV disinfection systems, one at the Orca treatment building and one at the Murcheson / Eyak treatment building. The Meals / Heney water supply will be delivered to the Murcheson / Eyak facility, where it would receive UV disinfection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cordova designates the LT2 Compliance UV Treatment Facility as the number one local state funding priority for the fiscal year 2012.


