

**CITY OF COROVA, ALASKA
RESOLUTION 10-10-60**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORDOVA, ALASKA,
SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT PROPOSAL TO THE DENALI
COMMISSION FOR THE RESURFACING OF CORDOVA STREETS/ROADS AND
COMMITTING CHIP AGGREGATE, EQUIPMENT, LABOR FORCE AND EXPERTISE,
WITH AN ESTIMATED VALUE OF \$72,168 AS IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION, AND
CONTRIBUTING \$45,000 OF MATCHING FUNDS TO THE PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, many of Cordova's streets have a chip sealed surface in need of re-surfacing;
and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission is accepting nominations for transportation projects
for which they will participate in the required cost of construction and/or reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the Cordova Public Works Department has identified a project to re-surface
its streets/roads for submission to the Denali Commission for their consideration; and

WHEREAS, the City has the chip aggregate, equipment, labor force and expertise to
contribute to an effort to apply asphalt surface treatment to Cordova streets/roads; and

WHEREAS, The City of Cordova's in-kind contributions have an estimated value of
\$72,168; and


WHEREAS, the City has set aside \$45,000 for Chip Seal Maintenance to be used as a
match to grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking grant funds to purchase CRS-2P emulsified asphalt for the
project in the amount of \$164,160.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of
Cordova hereby supports the submission of a Grant proposal to the Denali Commission for the re-
surfacing of Cordova streets/roads, and commits chip aggregate, equipment, labor force and
expertise, with an estimated value of \$72,168 as in-kind contribution, and contributes \$45,000 of
matching funds to the project.
