ITEM: Cash Flow Status and Revenue Opportunties

In FY23 \$3,896,575 was spent for long lead items for the harbor project. There also was \$816,000 spent from the harbor depreciation fund from 2022 to present. This has made a huge impact on the cash flow for the city. The balance in June FY24 was the lowest it had been in the last 5 years. This is important because the cash balance at the end of October must sustain the city through June of the following year. Historically, after November 1, City revenues (any inflow of cash) slow significantly and will likely average under \$750K per month (especially Nov - Mar) until next spring.

The 3-million-dollar permanent fund loan allowed for payments to Turnagain and started the recycling of funds for reimbursement, through MARAD. It did not help replace or reduce the stress on the city's cash flow.
